Word & Deed Prayer Update – Guatemala: Last week, we were notified by our partner, AMG Guatemala, that mass protests, called by the president-elect, are effectively shutting everything down in the country. This has caused violence to erupt in several areas, resulting in the loss of life. Goods, including food items and gasoline, cannot be transported due to blockades on roads. This is resulting in food shortages and also the cancellation of flights in and out of Guatemala. As a result of this situation, the AMG schools are all closed. The students in Guatemala are at the very end of their school year and have just to write their final exams before class is finished for the season. Please pray that these tests can be written soon and that blockades would dissipate, allowing for food, gasoline, and other supplies to travel freely in this country once again.

A Work Trip to San Jose, Costa Rica is being organized for this March! We hope to have a group of approximately 10 people who would be willing to travel to Costa Rica to help with the Reformed Christian School (CECRE- Centro Educativo Cristiano Reformado). Work will be tailored depending on the gifts of the group, such as construction (painting, fixing desks, building), teaching English or helping with after school Bible programs. No specific skills are needed except for a heart that is ready and willing to serve! The group will also have the opportunity to fellowship with our Tico brothers and sisters in Christ from our sister church, Pacto de Gracia (Rev. Bill Green).

A few details: While we hope to organize fundraisers that help cover costs, individuals should be prepared to cover the cost of their own flight.

- Passports are required for international travel.
- We encourage our youth to join the trip to share their gifts! However, due to airline restrictions, anyone under the age of 16 must travel with a parent.

• The exact date will depend on those interested, but we will try to line up the trip with DMC's spring break.
