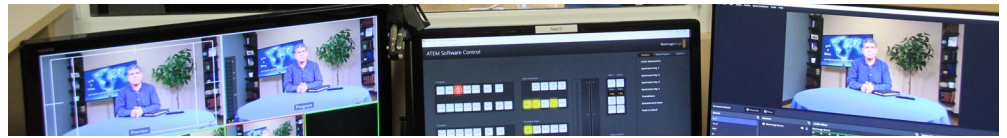




PATHWAY OF PEACE

FEAR & FAILURE OR FAITH & TRUST

Sometimes we hold back from stepping out in faith because we fear failure. What if no one shows up? What if I don't have all the answers? What if I'm not enough?

But when God calls, He doesn't ask us to depend on ourselves – He calls us to trust Him. This became real to me recently when God opened a surprising door in Hamilton, Ontario.

A local Canadian Reformed Church reached out about an Arabic-speaking family in their congregation. The family attended worship, but struggled to understand the services in English. I was asked if I could provide Arabic resources to help. As I prayed, I thought: Why not start an Arabic worship service?

To be honest, I wasn't sure what would happen. Would anyone come? Would it bear fruit?

But God had gone before us. At our very first Arabic service, about 20 people came. Since then, the number has grown – new people keep coming every month. The response has been so encouraging that we're now planning to meet twice a month, by God's grace.

AND GOD IS BEARING FRUIT

One family studied the Heidelberg Catechism and has asked to become members of the English Reformed church. Even more encouraging, believers are becoming bold in their witness. One sister told me: "Pastor, I've worked for years without ever speaking about my faith. But through the Bible teaching in this service, I found the courage to share the Gospel with my boss."

She answered her boss's questions, shared biblical materials, and her boss is now reading them. God is moving. And we rejoice in every step He leads.

This is what happens when we step out in faith, not in our strength, but in God's. He does the work. He brings the fruit.

"Not that we are sufficient in ourselves to claim anything as coming from us, but our sufficiency is from God." 2 Cor.

So, dear friends, don't be afraid to follow the Lord's leading. Trust Him, obey Him, and let Him work through you.

MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS

By God's grace, our media outreach, community programs, discipleship resources, and training opportunities continue to bear fruit. We see lives touched, minds renewed and people fed. The following are some areas where the Lord is using this ministry to make an impact:

MEDIA OUTREACH
