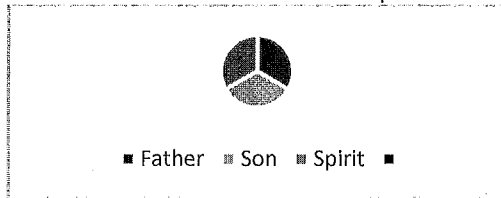

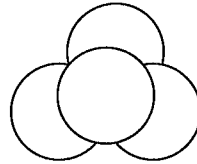

1. Is it correct to think of the person of the Trinity as 1/3 God? Explain your answer.

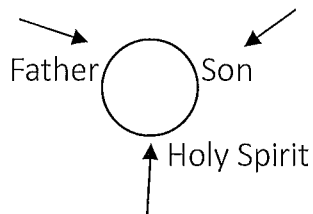


2. Why does this diagram unjustly represent the personal distinctions in the Trinity?
