Green is Executive Secretary for the *Latin American Fellowship of Reformed Churches* (CLIR) which has as its goal bringing Reformed churches and groups together throughout Latin America to strengthen church leaders, provide support for those who need it, and serve the propagation and defense of the Reformed faith.
